Warhammer World - about us

Warhammer World is the home of the Warhammer hobby. Situated in Nottingham, England, it boasts a visitor centre, bar, shops, gaming hall... and a massive Exhibition Centre packed with thousands of beautifully painted miniatures, not to mention immense dioramas. It's an inspirational destination for miniatures collectors, painters and gamers alike.



School and youth group visits - is this right for my group?

Our visit package is suitable for existing Warhammer clubs with some knowledge about Warhammer. This can include new members to the club that wish to find out more. Our visits are self-guided and in order to get the most from the experience, we recommend that groups who visit have at least one accompanying adult who is familiar with the Warhammer hobby who can guide learners during the experience. For this reason, it may not be suitable for whole class visits.

As the recommended age range of most of our products is 12+, we also limit visits to those in year 7 (the year in which they turn 12) and above.



Activities available for school and youth groups

Our services and facilities are free to use for schools and official youth groups such as the Scouts. When booking to bring your club you can tailor make your own group experience from the choices below.

We may ask you to split larger groups down so that they can cycle between different activities, giving everyone in your visit the best attention possible from our staff.

Exhibition Centre

Schools and qualifying youth groups can access the Exhibition Centre for free on pre-booked visits.

Inspire your young people with a self-guided tour and spark ideas for their next Warhammer project, or take your learning back to the classroom and incorporate your experience into your curriculum.

Gaming table reservations

Play an epic game on tables reserved exclusively for your group. These include the specially built feature tables exclusive to Warhammer World. Make sure your groups bring the equipment needed to play if you reserve a table.

Hobby stations

Bring your hobby tools, paints and miniatures and work on your projects at our hobby stations. Make a request so we can set an area aside just for you.

Game demonstrations

Get a feel for a game you haven't tried before and pre-book a fun and free demo of any of our games systems or boxed games with one of our experienced store staff.

Hobby demonstrations

If you have any new Warhammer club members, pre-book a quick painting demonstration for them so they can have a go during their visit.

Bugman's Bar

Food, drink and snacks are available in our dwarven themed restaurant and bar, Bugman's, during your visit. We'll reserve your group tables if required, or provide space to eat if you are bringing packed lunches. Visit this page to check the menu:

Parking

There is free parking on-site, and coaches can drop off and pick up. Please be aware if you are travelling by minibus that these spaces need to be reserved in advance.

Accessibility

Warhammer World is fully wheelchair accessible. If any of your group has any additional needs, such as needing a gaming table in a quieter area, or with extra room around it for accessibility, please make us aware at the time of booking so we can prepare any areas for you in advance.

First Aid

There are several fully trained first aiders on site at all times.

Public Transport

Safety

Warhammer World will be open to the general public during your visit. There are no facilities to store equipment such as coats and bags, so please ensure your personal possessions are never left unattended at any time.



Visiting Warhammer World - group visit requirements

Warhammer World is a relaxed and welcoming venue. In order for your group and all visitors to get the most enjoyment from their time here, we kindly ask you to keep the following things in mind when organising your visit.

- Please ensure your group is monitored by an appropriate number of responsible adults at all times. This means ensuring someone is always close at hand, rather than watching from a distance or allowing your group free-reign of the venue.
- Ensure your group is prepared with the correct equipment. This means making sure each member of the group has everything they need to play a game or work on their Warhammer project.
- We kindly ask all visitors to adhere to our no-running policy. Warhammer World has hard concrete floors and glass cabinets, which should be taken into account with your risk assessment.
- Please brief your students before arrival about the boundaries of the space. This means not
 interrupting other visitors and games taking place or touching models that aren't their own. It also
 includes other safety precautions such as always remaining in public areas and not leaving the building.
