



# LEGENDS OF PAINT

## **What is Legends of Paint?**

The Legends of Paint is an open format painting event ordinarily held at special events at Warhammer World. Each entry is judged on its own merit, so painters of all abilities can challenge themselves with a goal in mind: A Bronze, Silver or Gold pin.

## **Is Legends of Paint a painting competition?**

No - each entry is judged individually against an overall criteria for the awards. This ensures that painters of any level can engage with the event, without feeling like their painting isn't of a quality suitable to enter.

## **What are the entry requirements?**

Miniatures entered into Legends of Paint must have been built and painted by the person entering them and each entry must have a completed entry form accompanying it. There are no categories in Legends of Paint, though each event has a theme to adhere to. For this event the entry theme is any single Games Workshop miniature.

## **Where do I get an entry form?**

Entry forms are available at registration to fill out on the day of the event.

## **What is the criteria for winning a pin badge?**

The judges will be looking at each entry for a variety of qualities, to decide which level of award each entry should achieve. Technical skill, narrative atmosphere, consistency and overall finish are amongst the key components taken into consideration. The following serves as an outline for each achievable pin. Additional stipulations or criteria may be decided by judges at each event.

**No Prize** – The entry does not meet any of the following criteria

**Bronze Pin Badge** – The Bronze pin is the first achievable prize. It demonstrates that an entry is a great piece of painting where all parts of the model painted to a Parade Ready level

**Silver Pin Badge** – The silver pin is a prize given to fantastic entries that are a step above bronze, but may not be as refined as those that would win gold. Silver winners will have a Parade Ready model with a neater finish and finer detailing than Bronze winning miniatures.

**Gold Pin Badge** – the Gold pin badge denotes the best miniatures submitted to the Legends of Paint. Gold pins will be awarded for well executed Parade Ready miniatures, with a clean and crisp overall finish and high attention to detail.

## Youngbloods

For younger participants (aged 15 or below), the awards will be based on the following Criteria:

**No Prize** – The entry does not meet any of the following criteria

**Bronze** - All parts of the model painted to a Battle Ready level

**Silver** - Battle ready with neater and further refined finish than Bronze level.

**Gold** - Parade ready

Note younger participants may choose to have their entry judged against either the 'standard' or Youngbloods Criteria. Entrants aged 12 or below will also need parental / guardian consent to enter Legends of Paint.

### What is Parade Ready?

Parade Ready models have all parts of a model coloured, with shading and highlights added to represent light catching the edges of surfaces and areas of shadow. The bases of Parade Ready models will be of a higher standard than Battle Ready (see below) with further details added, such as shading, highlights and/or decorative elements such as grass tufts or rubble.

### What is Battle Ready?

Battle Ready models have their main areas coloured and a simple finish on their bases.

### Is there a limit of how many pins are awarded at the event?

No – There is no limit to how many Bronze, Silver or Gold pins are available at each event, if a model is judged to meet the criteria; it'll earn the relevant pin, irrespective of how many other miniatures have earned one.
